*Feb. 3rd, 1870, the 15th Amendment was ratified, allowing African American men the right to vote. * *Feb. 4th, 2004, "The Facebook" launched, becoming one of the largest social media platforms in the world. * *Feb. 8th, 1960, construction began on the Hollywood Walk of Fame, featuring 2,600 brass stars. * *Feb. 9th, 1943, the Battle of Guadalcanal ended, the first major Allied victory in the Pacific Theatre. * *Feb. 11th, 1963, The French Chef hosted by Julia Child premiered on PBS. * Feb. 11th, 1993, Janet Reno was appointed as the first female attorney general of the United States. * *Feb. 13th, 2000, the last *Peanuts* comic strip published, the day after Charles Schulz passed away. * *Feb. 14th, 1962, Jackie Kennedy gave a televised tour to millions of the newly renovated White House. * *Feb. 16th, 1968, the first 911 emergency calling system was introduced in Haleyville, Alabama. * *Feb. 21st, 1965, civil rights leader Malcolm X was assassinated in New York City. * *Feb. 24th, 1991, the royal engagement of Prince Charles, 36, and Lady Diana Spencer, 19, was announced. * *Feb. 26th, 1919, the Grand Canyon, spanning over 1.2 million acres in AZ, was designated a National Park * *Feb. 27th, 1991, President George H.W. Bush announced a ceasefire, ending the Gulf War. * *Feb. 28th, 1883, the t.v. series M*A*S*H aired its final episode to 105 million viewers. * *Feb. 28th, 1993, the Waco siege began when federal agents attempted to execute a search warrant at the compound of the Branch Davidians, a religious group led by David Koresh. The standoff lasted 51 days. * *Jan. 31st, 2006, Sandra Day O'Conner, the first woman to serve on the Supreme Court, retired. *


